RDA implementation/Templates:

An edition statement of [Large print edition] shall be added to all large print books if such language is not already on the item. Motion by Donna, second by Jon. Motion carries.

Reminder from Julie: under RDA, all sound recordings and video recordings should include a "title from" note.

MARCIVE cleanup:

General discussion about cleaning up headings in advance of sending the database out to MARCIVE. Some particulars:

Love | vJuvenile fiction should be coded 650 \_7 | 2local so it is preserved.

650 O Time travel | vFiction should be preserved

Anything coded 655 \_7 |2local should be OK.

We will use Spanish language materials or Spanish language materials | xBilingual without additional subdivisions.

Question: Which 650s will MARCIVE change to 655 0?

If a personal name entry has one and only one match to an authority record, but the authority record also has a date, MARCIVE recommends the date be added to the access point. We agreed to go with their recommendation.

Still waiting to see how MARCIVE will handle adding author/title and title authority records to both author and series, title and series indexes for series headings.

690s are not looked at by MARCIVE.

We will switch to 655 \_7 Detective and mystery films. |2lcgft There should now be no films genre headings coded |2gsafd

Plan is still to send out the database the week of Thanksgiving.

While the database is out, bib. Records cannot be edited unless they are new records you have imported or short order bibs.

New records hoperfully will be sent out around the end of January.

From then on, MARCIVE will perform overnight processing on bib records. Bibs will be identified as "sent to MARCIVE," meaning don't edit them until they come back, or identified as processed, meaning they can be edited but any additional authority work will need to be done by the cataloger.

Donna will check with EC on the continued use of |xAudio-visual aids.

\*Addendum: Donna reported back that Eau Claire no longer sees a need for the use of |xAudio-visual aids as a subdivision; these will be removed and not added to future records.

Question: What will MARCIVE do with authority records that say "Give as a quoted note" but which people have been coding as a series?

Series differentiated by publisher: MORE prefers not to have these so that, for instance, regular print, large print, and audiobooks for the same author's series use the same form. Usually this is not a problem since the regular print series is not differentiated and can serve as the model form. However, one counterexample is McDonald, Megan. | tSisters Club (Candlewick Press). How will MARCIVE handle differentiated series headings? Will we need to change our policy if differentiation becomes the standard for regular print materials?
