7. Evaluation of 'Coming Soon' genre headings survey

22 responses:

- 19 yes
- 2 no (including from one respondent who also responded with “yes”)
- 1 no opinion

8. Genre headings for consideration (patterns, etc)

Genre use in records to consider include: Illustrated Works, Educational Works, Patterns, Pattern Books, Recipes.

9. Local genre heading for Library of Things/Library of Experiences/Experience Kits

As libraries add more diverse items to their collections, some are looking for a way to gather up these disparate materials. New Richmond (at least) would like to use “Library of Things;” Ellsworth (at least) would like to see “Library of Experiences” and “Experience kits” added.

10. Local genre label for OwnVoices

#OwnVoices is a term coined by the writer Corinne Duyvis, and refers to an author from a marginalized or under-represented group writing about their own experiences/from their own perspective, rather than someone from an outside perspective writing as a character from an underrepresented group.
