

At a minimum, maintain the level of funding for both public library system aid and library service contracts in the Governor's proposed budget.

Public Library System aid: Current amount \$15,031,000 SEG in each fiscal year **Library Service Contracts:** Current amount \$1,167,200 SEG in each fiscal year

Current law (43.24 (6), Wis. Stats.) requires the Department of Public Instruction (Division for Libraries and Technology) to set public library systems funding at a 13% index level of the previous year's local and county expenditures in its biennial budget request.

Current funding is at 6.9% index level. DPI did request an additional \$13,879,500 FY 16 and \$14,168,400 FY17 to meet the 13% requirement, but did not request any additional library service contract funding.



A network of library systems serves 381 local public libraries across the state.

Indianhead Federated Library System(IFLS) supports ten counties in northwest Wisconsin, including Barron, Chippewa, Dunn, Eau Claire, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Price, Rusk, and St. Croix counties. There are 54 public library members in the IFLS system, assisting

a population of 459,247 with 226,596 registered borrowers. System services keep local library doors open.

Approve the Governor's proposed increase in funding for Badgerlink and Newsline for the Blind to maintain the current level of access to services and cover increased cost for the contract with the Wisconsin Newspaper Association.

Current annual amount: \$2,479,000 SEG

Requested amount: \$2,965,400 (2015-16) SEG \$3,025,800 (2016-17) SEG

- More than 130 million searches are conducted annually using BadgerLink and Newsline resources.
- The materials are provided exclusively for use by all Wisconsin residents via the Internet and are not available through regular search engines such as Google.
- BadgerLink offers 46 databases that help users prepare for interviews and build job skills, make smart health decisions, aid in student success, stay competitive in the marketplace, and connect with their roots, all at a huge cost savings to local communities.
- It is estimated that individual libraries, schools, universities and other organizations would pay approximately \$73-75 million to directly purchase BadgerLink databases.

Library Perceptions

Libraries play an important role in our communities

- 95% of Americans ages 16 and older agree that materials and resources available at public libraries play an important role in giving everyone a chance to succeed;
- 95% say that public libraries are important because they promote literacy and a love of reading;
- 94% say that having a public library improves the quality of life in a community;
- 81% say that public libraries provide many services people would have a hard time finding elsewhere.

Libraries are also particularly valued by those who are unemployed, retired, or searching for a job, as well as those living with a disability and internet users who lack home internet access:

- 56% of internet users without home access say public libraries' basic technological resources (such as computers, internet, and printers) are "very important" to them and their family, *compared with 33% of all respondents*.
- 49% of unemployed and retired respondents say librarian assistance in finding information to be "very important," *compared with 41% of employed respondents.*
- 47% of job seekers say help finding or applying for a job is "very important" to them and their families.
- 40% of those living with a disability say help applying for government services is "very important," *compared with 27% of those without a disability.*
