2023 Preliminary MORE Budget notes:

- First of four 2023 MORE budget versions
- Represents no changes to current MORE services or products
- Incorporates some expected cost increases
- Combines all IFLS services into a single "IFLS Management Charges" line
- Factors in the use of \$60,000 in (uncommitted) carryover funds
- Uses the <u>approved formula involving 3-year averages</u> for cost-to-library allocations

Individual libraries could subscribe, but a single system-wide subscription could allow for improved training for all MORE-member library staff, and possibly also resources for library users via the MORE Catalog.

BiblioCloud Records allows for the automatic display of all OverDrive content available to MOREmember library cardholders via the main MORE Catalog without the need for staff intervention.

Currently, MORE Project Manager Bridget Krejci imports into MORE and edits MARC records for OverDrive holdings (ebooks, e-audiobooks, and digital magazines) for display in the main MORE Catalog, Sierra, and the Classic Catalog.

This product would reduce Bridget's time spent on loading and managing these local records. It would also eliminate the current delay in getting OverDrive content to appear in the main MORE Catalog, would ensure full coverage in MORE of OverDrive content available to local users, and could reduce fulfillment issues for patrons trying to access available OverDrive content through their account in the MORE Catalog.
