

Online Patron Registration Policy Recommendation

Recommended to MORE Directors Council by MORE Executive Committee, November 2, 2018;

Revised by MORE Operations Committee for MORE Executive Committee, February 18, 2019

Patrons may register for a MORE library account online for access to non-physical electronic resources. Access via a system-generated barcode number will be granted when the registration form is submitted. These patrons' records will have a distinct patron type code and a home library of "MORE."

To register online, patrons must provide:

- Full name
- Wisconsin residential address
- County of residence
- Birthdate
- Email address

MORE Directors Council will determine the electronic resources to which these patrons have access. Libraries may allow access to locally-funded resources, but are not required to do so.

Patrons may have either a MORE-member library card with full privileges, or an account for online access to electronic resources only. Library and / or system staff will make a reasonable effort to delete any record created online via patron registration which:

- Is a duplicate of an existing patron record based on name and birthdate
- Does not include a residential address in Wisconsin

Patrons who register online may later get a MORE-member library card with full privileges by completing the standard registration process as outlined in [MORE's Patron Registration Policy](#).

Patron records created via online patron registration will be deleted 1 year after the date of last use.
