Shared annual fee: \$18,000, per vendor modification, March 17, 2021. "The Mobile App base rate will stay the same [after year 1], the only change would be whatever annual inflationary rate is allowed in our current agreements." Innovative Mobile

Pros:

- Customizable home screen links
- Can be an entry point to the wider scope of library services
- Seamless Sierra integration
- Linked Account option to view activity on multiple cards. This is separate from Sierra's Linked Patrons; patrons must add additional accounts manually. Checkouts and Holds for all accounts can be viewed from account pages
- More prominent "Place hold" button
- Optional add-ons can be implemented library-by-library
- Larger customer base

Cons:

- Doesn't match main online catalog interface
- Less information on search results and title detail pages
- Innovative contracts with app developer rather than having full development control

BiblioApps

Pros:

- Matches main catalog interface
- Home screen shows account summary
- Displays more title information
- Consistent navigation
- Lower cost
- Developed directly by vendor, more agile development
- Access to Shelves and Borrowing History

Cons:

- No option to link to other patron accounts
- Fewer customizing options (links, layout, etc.)
- Self-check option is all-or-nothing
- Smaller customer base

Commonalities between the apps:

- Integration with OverDrive, but not Freading or Flipster
- No push notifications
- No system-wide, shared programming calendar
- "Scan and search" ISBN look-up
- Patron barcode storage
